

Situated in the Township of Auburn, County of Geauga, and State of Ohio, and known as being part of Lot 2 in Section 2 of Tract 2 in said township, and further bounded and described as follows;

Beginning at the centerline intersection of Munn Road and Washington Street;

thence North 0° 56′ 30" West, along said centerline of Munn Road, and passing over a monument found at 3.00 feet, a distance of 1297.00 feet to a point at the northeast corner of land conveyed to B. and J. Edic by deed recorded in Volume 732, Page 1188 of Geauga County Record of Deeds;

thence North 89° 26' West, along the north line of said Edic's land, a distance of 203.11 feet to a 5/8" iron pin found at the northwest corner thereof and the TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel herein described:

thence South 0° 56′ 30" West, along the west line of said Edic's land, a distance of 84.90 feet to a 5/8" capped rebar set;

thence North 89° 44′ 51" West, a distance of 388.83 feet to a 5/8" capped rebar set;

thence North 1° 35' East, a distance of 87.04 feet to a 1/2" iron pin found at the southwest corner of land conveyed to C. and C. Schneider by deed recorded in Volume 633, Page 1089 of Geauga County Record of Deeds;
