

DESCRIPTION OF A 2.963 ACRE PARCEL FOR KEVIN FINNERTY

Beginning for reference at a monument found at the intersection of the centerlines of Auburn Road and Taylor May Road;

thence N 86°-26'-10"W along the centerline of Taylor May Road a distance of 621.64 feet to an iron pin set at the southwest corner of lands of Charles M. and Nancy Ward as recorded in Volume 635, Page 53 of the Geauga County Records of Deeds, said iron pin being the true place of beginning of the parcel herein described;

thence continuing N 86°-26'-10"W (reference bearing) along the centerline of said Taylor May Road a distance of 367.03 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N 3°-33'-50"E a distance of 30.00 feet to an iron pin set on the northerly right-of-way line of said Taylor May Road;

thence along a curve to the right having a radius of 40.00 feet, an arc length of 64.76 feet, a central angle of 92° - 45° - 36° , a chord bearing of N 40° - 03° - 22° W, a chord distance of 57.91 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N 6°-19'-26"E a distance of 27.49 feet to an iron pin set;

thence along a curve to the right having a radius of 220.00 feet, an arc length of 118.17 feet, a central angle of 30° -46'-31", a chord bearing of N 21° -42'-42"E, a chord distance of 116.75 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N 37°-05'-57"E a distance of 69.28 to an iron pin set;

thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 280.00 feet, an arc length of 57.03 feet, a central angle of 11°-40'-08", a chord bearing of N 31°-15'-53"E, a chord distance of 56.93 feet to an iron pin set;

thence along a curve to the right having a radius of 40.00 feet, an arc length of 30.76 feet, a central angle of $44^{\circ}-03^{\circ}-16^{\circ}$, a chord bearing of N $47^{\circ}-27^{\circ}-27^{\circ}$ E, a chord distance of 30.00 feet to an iron pin set;

thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 75.00 feet, an arc length of 26.74 feet, a central angle of 20°-25'-50", a chord bearing of N 59°-16'-10"E, a chord distance of 26.60 feet to an iron pin set;

thence S 86°-39'-43"E a distance of 260.38 feet to an iron pin set, said iron pin being on the westerly line of lands of said Charles M. and Nancy Ward;

thence S 30-20'-17"W along the westerly line of said Ward lands a distance of 356.12 feet, passing through an iron pipe found at 326.99 feet, to the place of beginning, containing 2.963 acres, more or less, and being subject to all legal right-of-ways and easements.

Beginning for reference at a monument found at the intersection of the centerlines of Auburn Road and Taylor May Road;

thence N 86°-26'-10"W along the centerline of Taylor May Road a distance of 988.67 feet to an iron pin set, said iron pin being the true place of beginning of the parcel herein described;

thence continuing N 86°-26'-10"W (reference bearing) along the centerline of said Taylor May Road a distance of 258.46 feet to an iron pin set, said iron pin being at the southeasterly corner of lands of Richard C. Roubic as recorded in Volume 732, Page 1226, of the Geauga County Records of Deeds;

thence N 3°-20'-18"E along the easterly line of said Roubic lands a distance of 1045.74 feet to an iron pin set, said iron pin being at the northeasterly corner of said Roubic lands, said iron pin also being on the southerly line of lands of John M. Lawrence as recorded in Volume 559, Page 413, of said Geauga County Records, passing through an iron pin set for reference at 30.00 feet;

thence S 86°-17'-27"E along the southerly line of said Lawrence lands a distance of 625.49 feet to an iron pipe found, said iron pipe being at the northwesterly corner of lands of Michael L. and Karen A. Small as recorded in Volume 794, Page 962, and Volume 795, Page 492, of said Geauga County Records;

thence S 3°-20'-17"W along the westerly line of said Small lands and also the westerly line of lands of John H. Ward as recorded in Volume 714, Page 1195, and lands of Charles M. and Nancy Ward as recorded in Volume 635, Page 53, of said Geauga County Records, a distance of 688.03 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N 86°-39'-43"W a distance of 260.38 feet to an iron pin set;

thence along a curve to right having a radius of 75.00 feet, an arc length of 26.74 feet, a central angle of 20°-25'-50", a chord bearing of S 59°-16'-10"W, a chord distance of 26.60 feet to an iron pin set;

thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 40.00 feet, an arc length of 30.76 feet, a central angle of 44°-03'-16", a chord bearing of S 47°-27'-27"W, a chord distance of 30.00 feet to an iron pin set;

thence along a curve to the right having a radius of 280.00 feet, an arc length of 57.03 feet, a central angle of 11°-40'-08", a chord bearing of S 31°-15'-53"W, a chord distance of 56.93 feet to an iron pin set;

thence S 37°-05'-57"W a distance of 69.28 feet to an iron pin set;

thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 220.00 feet, an arc length of 118.17 feet, a central angle of 30°-46'-31", a chord bearing of S 21°-42'-42"W, a chord distance of 116.75 feet to an iron pin set;

thence S 6°-19'-26"W a distance of 27.49 feet to an iron pin set;

thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 40.00 feet, an arc length of 64.76 feet, a central angle of 92°-45'-36", a chord bearing of S 40°-03'-22"E, a chord distance of 57.91 feet to an iron pin set on the northerly right-of-way line of said Taylor May Road;

thence S 3°-33'-50"W a distance of 30.00 feet to the place of beginning, containing 12.042 acres, more or less, and being subject to all legal right-of-ways and easements.
